This is a REPUBLIC—not a democracy. Let's keep it that way.

"I pledge allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and to the REPUBLIC for which it stands. . . ." A democracy is rule by majority either directly or through elected representatives. Action need not be just . . . it need only be the will of the majority (mob lynching is a form of pure democracy in action.) The American REPUBLIC is rule by representatives elected by the majority of voters but whose actions are controlled and limited by a CONSTITUTION. It guarantees justice for the weak and all the minorities—even against the will of the majority. This is the definition given by the Founders of our American REPUBLIC (read the Federalist Papers and see Article IV, Section 4 of the Constitution which states, "The United States shall guarantee to every State in this Union a REPUBLICAN form of government . . ."). Which do you prefer?
